Loqsjo Edsberg - Jan. 14, 1927

Dearest mine - a good new year is wished.

a big thank you for your welcome letter. We are all well. God be thanked and praised. Thanks for your welcome gift. Quite strangely the letter came days before Christmas, but the money came almost 14 days later at the post office in Edsberg - an unexpected, but welcome gift. Also from Gottfrid with 40 Crowns. From Sven we also had a letter, but he could not send anything. He has had a large hospital bill, but it was good that he remembered us. Always we did not hear from. We have not heard from him since Feb. 1926 when he had aurtian. We have had a nice winter with no snow until just now as I write this ^{not cold}.

Anna thanks you for the stamps. They have been scarce and expensive - 200 Crowns. Have written a little of everything if you can read it. But as long as I can you will excuse me. I am sending enclosed a picture - if you can recognize your old father.
